Woodgrain Pattern Installation

Longboard's woodgrains have a range in both color tone and pattern repeat. It's important to identify the tone and pattern of the project's selected finish, to assign a pattern "A" & "B". This is achieved by opening a few boxes of product and creating a preferred pattern mixture. Be sure to maintain a net 50/50 ratio of A's & B's, to minimize waste.

Staggered butt-joints also help to break up the repeat pattern while still maintaining your planned install.
